# Re-Entry Action Plan

### 1 BE CLEAR & SPECIFIC

Make your REAP simple and achievable. Don't try to solve all the problems in the world but make sure it's value-adding. It should demonstrate the competencies you will acquire in Australia.

### 2 WRITE S.M.A.R.T. OBJECTIVES

Align your REAP with your organisation's goals. Work within your circles of influence and aim to do your REAP within a year.

### 3 BE RESPONSIVE

Consult with stakeholders in your host organisation. Your REAP should be able to contribute to the needs of the organisation.

### 4 BE RESOURCEFUL

Do something with the resources available to you, whether it be time, money, or people. Development doesn't have to be expensive.

### 5 BE PASSIONATE

Pick a topic that is meaningful to you and to others. Find a mentor who is passionate about your topic.
