2019 Australian Alumni Excellence Awards

Who is eligible?

Filipinos who have graduated from a recognised **Australian educational institution or Australian accredited training organisation** including participants in short-term courses*.



**All alumni except past winners may apply or be nominated.*

***Nominees or applicants should be Philippine residents.*

How can I nominate?

Nominations can be done through:

- Self-nomination
- Third party nomination



All nominators should complete and submit the **nomination form and supporting documents** found at www.australiaawardsphilippines.org/alumni/aea

What are the Award categories and selection criteria?

Alumni of the Year



- Demonstrated **visionary leadership and best practice** at a local or international level.
- Evidence of **outstanding contribution** to their profession or industry.

Excellence in Innovation Award



- Demonstrated **innovation in their field or industry**. This can include: creation of a successful enterprise or project; creative new ideas, designs or products for industry or government; or innovative research findings.
- Evidence of **outstanding contribution** to their profession or industry.

Young Achievers Award*



- Demonstrated **achievements or contributions in their chosen field**, and potential to **create future impact**.

**Alumni nominated for the Young Achievers Award must not be older than 35 years as of 30 April 2019.*

What is the selection process?

Nominations will be accepted online until close of business on 30 April 2019.

Shortlisted nominations will undergo personal and professional background checking and will be evaluated by a selection panel.

Winners will be recognised at a Gala Reception hosted by the Australian Embassy in June 2019.
