# APPLICATION PROCESS

## The Australia Awards application process

is open and competitive, providing equal opportunity to all eligible citizens regardless of gender, ethnicity and disability.



## What are the **important dates to remember?**

- 1 February to April** Online Application
- 2 May to June** Shortlisting of Candidates
- 3 July** Panel Interview
- 4 August** Selection of Candidates
- 5 August to November** Pre-Mobilisation Activities (Course Counselling, Pre-Departure Briefing, University Placement, Processing of Visa)

## Online Application



Applications are **submitted online** through the Australia Awards Philippines online application system [www.australiaawardsphilippines.org](http://www.australiaawardsphilippines.org)

- 1 Find out if you're eligible.** Get assessed through our online pre-qualification test.
- 2 Create an account in our online platform** to begin your application. Verify your email and log in on your account.
- 3 Upload documents.** Once logged in, you can find on your dashboard an application link where you can fill in your details\* and upload required documents.
- 4 Keep deadline in mind.** Deadline of applications is every 30 April at 11:59pm

## The Application Form

The form has **15 sections**

- 8** Memberships in organisations
- 9** Awards and citations
- 10** Publications
- 11** Proposed study
- 12** Re-entry action plan (REAP)
- 13** Supporting statement
- 14** Previous scholarships
- 15** Equal opportunity

### **Tips** in submitting an application



#### Save as you go.

You can work on the form section by section, and "save as you go" until you are ready to submit your application. (It's not something you fill out and complete in one go.)



#### Note the word count.

Your response to some questions has a corresponding word count.



#### Double check accuracy of information.

Ensure that you provide accurate information especially your personal details (i.e., contact details).



#### Don't wait for the deadline to submit your application.
